



## 20.C Proposal Coversheet

You will complete your Proposal Coversheet on the DSIP website. We recommend that you prepare your information on this sheet so you can easily copy & paste the information over to the website.

Additionally, please ensure that AFWERX is selected as the “component” when you build the proposal, or it may not be evaluated.

1. Technical Abstract: Your Coversheet must include a brief technical abstract no more than **200** words describing the proposed R&D project, including anticipated benefits and potential commercial applications. **Do not include proprietary or classified information as your abstract may be released publicly.**

2. Anticipated Benefits: The first line of the ‘Anticipated Benefits’ section should follow this format:

*“We solved **[AF problem]** by providing **[advantage]**, to help **[AF end-user organization]** accomplish **[AF end-user’s]** goal. We will recognize profit by charging **[non-defense commercial customer organizations]** to get **[non- defense commercial benefit]**. “*

This list should also include non-proprietary, non-defense commercial customers. **Do not include specific AF names or non-defense customers, as this section will be publicly released.**
